




1. Starting Official Starts Race (horn sounds light flashes)

2. Computer Starts Time


& Lap Count Scoreboard Starts Showing Times

(Length for each race is preprogrammed into the computer)

 Timers Take & Record Final Times Incase of a Computer Malfunction

- 3. Touch Pads
  - There is a Pad in Each Lane Each Time A Swimmer Contacts The Pad The Computer Calculates The Official "Split Time" or a "Final Time"





Time: Will Continue to Go Until That lanes Pad is Touched Resulting in a Split Time or Final Time

"Split Time" is The Time of an <u>Individual</u> Lap

For Example: A 200 Yard Race Will Have 4 Laps With 3 Split Times & 1 Final Time
